INLAND POSTAL REGULATIONS.

Letters.—After the charge of 1d. for the first oz. and 1½d. for 2 ozs., the scale advances uniformly without limit of weight by ¼d. for each additional 2 ozs. or fraction of 2 ozs. The limits of size are—length 18 ins., width 9 ins., depth 6 ins. *Foreign and Colonial*, 2½d. per ¼ oz.

Book Post.—The Rates of Postage are—¼d. for every 2 ozs. or part of 2 ozs. The limits of weight and size are—weight 5 lbs.; size—length 18 ins., width 9 ins., depth 6 ins.

Parcel Post.—The Rates of Postage are—3d. for 1 lb., and 1½d. for every additional lb. up to 11 lbs. The limits of size are—greatest length 3 ft. 6 ins.; greatest length and girth combined 6 ft.

Compensation for loss or damage to an amount not exceeding £2 will be given without payment of any special Fee, if Certificate of Posting has been obtained.

Registered Letters, Parcels, & Packets.—The Fees for Registering a letter, parcel, or other postal packet, and the respective limits of Compensation are as follows:—2d. for £5, and 1d. for each additional £5 up to £50.

Post Cards.—10 thick, 6d.; 10 thin, 5½d.; singly, ¾d. **Letter Cards.**—Single, 1¼d.; 8 for 9d. **Embossed Envelopes**, with ½d. Stamp, for Circulars, etc., in open covers, at book rates—'Commercial,' 10 for 5½d.; 'Foolscap,' 10 for 6d.

Express Delivery.—Letters and Parcels. Fee—not exceeding 1 lb., for every mile and under, 3d.; for every other lb. or fraction of lb. 1½d. Express Delivery of Letters and Parcels by Mail—Fee, 3d. per mile, in addition to ordinary postage.

Telegrams.—6d. for the first *twelve words*, and ¼d. for every additional word. Addresses are charged for.

Money Orders.—The scale of charges for Inland Money Orders is as follows:—
